Course on Water Supply Network Management



SIWW 2020 will have a strong focus on smart utilities, including smart water supply networks.

In the lead-up to the event, the Singapore Water Academy (established by PUB, Singapore's National Water Agency), will be organising a five-day Water Supply Network Management course from 13 to 17 January 2020.
