

Since the launch of the BCA Green Mark scheme in 2005, Singapore has made good progress in raising the environmental performance of buildings, both new and existing. BCA has had three iterations of Green Building Masterplans (GBMPs). One major aspiration of the GBMPs is the greening 80% of Singapore's buildings by year 2030. To date, we have greened around 40% of our buildings (by GFA).

2 As we embark together with the Singapore Green Building Council (SGBC) on our next GBMP: Singapore Green Building Masterplan (SGBMP) 2020, it is opportune to involve a wider group of stakeholders, in particular the youths, as we raise awareness on green buildings and explore how we can tap on their energy and views to bring us forward in the next lap.
