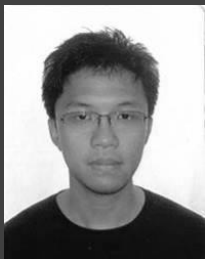
Ar Lee Shiuh Liang Jason
