This seminar launches the new Technical Reference on *Storage, Land Transportation and Handling of LNG*.

This new standard is intended to support the growth of the local LNG industry through the development of an operating guidelines for handling LNG while taking into consideration of safety, health and environmental aspects.

Highlights of this new standard will be presented by the Working Group experts who developed TR 74 : 2020. MOM will use this standard in the assessment of LNG handling and storage so as to determine if there are adequate measures in place for ensuring safe LNG work practices. SCDF will be referencing to this new standard for the approval of fire safety plan submission and P&FM license application for organisations that are involved in the LNG land operations.
