BIM Modelling (Structure)

The Basics of Design for Manufacturing & Assembly (DfMA)

DfMA is a key pillar of Singapore's Construction Industry Transformation Map (ITM). It is a game-changing method of construction which involves construction being designed for manufacturing off-site in a controlled environment, before being assembled on-site.

This course will provide insights into design consideration for DfMA, and illustrates how DfMA can shorten the construction period, improve workmanship and reduce dis-amenities.
