The Singapore Parliament has passed the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) Act 2020 (Act) in April this year which offer temporary relief to contractors who are unable to perform their contractual obligations due on or after 1st February 2020 because of COVID-19.

The Act has been extended until 31 March 2021, and there have been further amendments to the Act, relation impacting the construction industry.
