Subject: [Invitation] Industry demonstration workshop on new online reporting module (under EDMA) for EEOA (RC)

Dear all,

With effect from 1 January 2020, a registered corporation (RC) under the Energy Conservation Act (ECA) must conduct an Energy Efficiency Opportunities Assessment (EEOA) for the relevant business activity under its operational control, and submit an assessment report to NEA before the expiry of the respective assessment period.

- For the first EEOA,
 - a. A RC that established operational control of a relevant business activity on or before 2 June 2017 must –
 - i. Conduct EEOA and submit the EEOA report by 31 December 2021.
 - b. A RC that established operational control of a relevant business activity after 2 June 2017 must –
 - i. Conduct EEOA and the EEOA report within 6 years from the day the RC established operational control of the relevant business activity.
- EEOA Report must be:
 - i. signed off by the energy efficiency opportunities assessor; and
 - ii. endorsed by the chief executive of the RC.

2 The detailed requirements of the EEOA on RC which came into operation on 1 Jan 2020 can be found in this [link](#). A new online reporting module under the Emissions Data Monitoring and Analysis (EDMA) system has been developed to facilitate the submission of EEOA (RC) reports.

3 To aid the industry practitioners and relevant stakeholders in familiarizing with the new online reporting module, NEA will be conducting online demonstration workshops. The date and time for the session, is as follows:
