

## **CALL FOR INDUSTRY COMMENTS ON PROPOSED CHANGES TO ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW BUILDING DEVELOPMENTS AND EXISTING BUILDINGS**

In 2020, BCA and the Singapore Green Building Council (SGBC) have co-led the co-creation of the next Singapore Green Building Masterplan<sup>1</sup> (SGBMP) with stakeholders from the public, private and people sectors, including Trade Associations and Chambers (TACs). One of the key initiatives under the SGBMP is to review the environmental sustainability requirements to support the strive towards more energy efficient buildings.

2. We have earlier worked with the SGBMP working committees on the energy efficiency measures for buildings. Several industry practitioners were engaged and have provided their feedback on the areas of improvements to the Code requirements.
