**[REMINDER] APPLICATION OF AQUATIC FACILITY LICENCE AND REGISTRATION OF COOLING TOWERS**

This circular is to remind owners/occupiers to apply for an Aquatic Facility (AF) licence for the existing and new water playgrounds (including interactive water fountains) and multi-use spa pools, and/or to register the cooling towers.

2 We encourage owners/occupiers, who have not done so, to apply for the licence and register early, so that sufficient time is catered for the processing to be completed successfully.

4 For licensed swimming pools, if the pools have aerosol-generating features (e.g. fountains, etc.), licensees are required to amend the 'Type of AF' licence via GoBusiness.

5 It is mandatory under the Environmental Public Health (Registrable Aerosol-generating Systems) Regulations 2021 for all owners/occupiers of cooling towers, including those who have previously registered manually, to register their cooling towers through the NEA ePortal.
