In June, we successfully organised our first ever fully virtual SIWW. This was augmented by two additional months of on-demand period for wider learning and business opportunities. The virtual event received more than 5,000 attendees and 16,000 views. international water shows to be held in-person in Asia since the onset of the pandemic, SIWW2022 provides the ideal setting for leaders, experts, and practitioners to resume face-to-face interactions, renew peer-to-peer learning and rebuild business partnerships. Held alongside our sister event, the [CleanEnviro Summit Singapore](#), we are expecting close to 15,000 attendees. For wider knowledge dissemination, all SIWW2022 content would be available for on-demand viewing.

Recently, all eyes were on Scotland last month as the world descended onto Glasgow for COP26. For the water sector, one thing is for sure – amidst the global movement in addressing climate change and securing global net zero, water sits at the very heart of climate mitigation and adaption solutions.

To play our part in advocating urgent climate action for a sustainable water future, SIWW2022 will be focusing on the emerging themes of climate resilience, net zero, resource circularity, sustainability, and digital water across all elements of the programme.

In SIWW2022, the **Water Leaders Summit** will bring global water leaders together to share strategies, policy insights, and solutions to tackle urban water challenges, alongside **Water Convention, Thematic and Business Forums** which will gather experts and practitioners to exchange technical knowledge through case studies and technological solutions. The **Water Expo** features a melting pot of products and services, with more than 300 exhibitors, 14 country/regional pavilions, and three new thematic Pavilions providing a one-stop marketplace for buyers looking for innovative urban water solutions. Another key highlight of SIWW2022 is the **Lee Kuan Yew Water Prize 2020**. Awarded at the event, the Prize recognises the achievements of a water expert for his/her outstanding contributions in tackling the world's water problems. Singapore is at the forefront of nearly all countries that have formulated a long-term plan for managing climate change and is steadfastly implementing that plan.

The small island state of 6 million people was among the 40 nations invited by the US President Joe Biden to attend his leaders' summit on tackling climate change last April.

Singapore is one of most densely populated countries in the world. It faces the twin challenges of ensuring sustainable water supply during droughts as well as effective drainage during intense rain seasons amid climate change.

Much of Singapore is also as flat as a pancake and stands no more than 5 metres above the mean sea level. This puts the country at risk from rising sea level due to climate change.
