Speakers' Profiles and Synopses of Presentations



Chan Yew Kwong Senior Consultant, Workplace Safety and Health Council, Tripartite Alliance Ltd

Yew Kwong is the Senior Consultant in the Workplace Safety & Health Council (WSHC), Singapore since July 2019. He retired from the Ministry of Manpower's Occupational Safety & Health Division (OSHD) in April 2019, after having served in the Ministry for about 35 years in various management roles. One of the key management roles was the Director of OSH Inspectorate and Deputy Commissioner for WSH where he oversaw the development and execution of enforcement strategies and programmes for regulatory compliance and surveillance across all industries, and the effective implementation of OSH standards at the workplaces.

Yew Kwong is also very involved in the development and promotion of WSH-related Singapore Standards in Singapore. He was a Member of the Singapore Standards Council (SSC) for 6 years from Apr 2011 and Chairman of the SSC's General Engineering and Safety Standards Committee from 1 Apr 2004 to 31 Mar 2017. He is currently the Advisor to the SSC's Quality & Safety Standard Committee. He was a Member of the Ministry of Defence's 2nd External Review Panel on SAF Safety (Jul 2017 to Dec 2020) and currently serving on the Maritime Port Authority's National Maritime Safety at Sea Council since 1 Jun 2015 to-date.

Synopsis

Reducing risk at source is key to improving construction safety and health. In July 2015, the Ministry of Manpower gazetted the WSH (Design for Safety) Regulations to require developers and designers address design risks at the design and planning phase of a construction project. Design for Safety (DfS) addresses the risks inherent in the design of a building / structure and identify the means to mitigate them prior to construction, occupation, maintenance and even demolition.

DfS can be a holistic approach to prevent or reduce occupational injuries, illnesses, and fatalities through the inclusion of prevention considerations in all designs that impact workers. This short presentation will share on what and how DfS can be applied beyond construction industry.



Ashith Alva Head - Project Design, Development and Management (Jewel Changi Airport Devt Pte Ltd Ashith has close to 26 years' experience in the Built Environment sector of which close to 20 years is with the CapitaLand group, working on various projects, from AEI works to greenfield developments. Notable AEI's are Raffles City and Bugis Junction and greenfield developments such as The Star Vista and Jewel Changi Airport.

Synopsis

Jewel Changi Airport was constructed on time, within budget and importantly without any major safety incident. This was possible because of the safety management framework that the project followed. The developers engaged a specialist Safety consultant at the outset and all stakeholders committed to work together to deliver the project without compromising on safety. This included training, regular monitoring of safety incidents, interventions and remedial measures where necessary and recognition of good safety practices. Ashith will share his info experiences on the effectiveness of this approach.



Allan Tan Managing Director, United Tec Construction Pte Ltd Allan has worked in the construction field for 40 years on projects in Europe, Africa and Asia. Spending the last 20+ years in Singapore, he has attained an enormous insight into the Singapore built environment industry and is well connected across the value chain. He is constantly engaged with BCA, developers, consultants and trade specialists in spearheading construction innovation and technology.

In the last 8 years, he pioneered steel and concrete PPVC system and followed through by partnering with BCA and Consultants in pushing for continued PPVC adoption in projects nationwide. He has successfully implemented PPVC in residential, hotel and healthcare projects, including the worlds tallest PPVC project – Avenue South Residence in Singapore. The Avenue South Residence project was the recipient of the SHARP award, which required an accident-free period of at least 750,000 manhours.

In 2018, Allan set up his own company, United Tec Construction. In the company's 4 years of operation, they achieved an order book of over S\$1 billion, and have been awarded 6 PPVC projects. He remains passionate about the built environment, and is currently focused on growing his company while also helping the industry continue to adopt innovative methods to improve productivity.

Synopsis

As adoption of DfMA increases in the construction industry of Singapore, it is an opportunity for DfMA to improve on existing safety standards. By shifting up to 70% of construction work off site, the Prefabricated Prefinished Volumetric Construction (PPVC) method provides opportunities to create a safer working environment. Allan will share his perspective on trends and best practices from his past PPVC experience, including the world's tallest PPVC building, the Avenue South Residence project.
