AGC obtains its first Environmental Product Declaration for Architectural Glass Products in Asia Pacific Region

SGBC Established Member, AGC, has obtained its first **Environmental Product Declaration** (EPD) for float glass manufactured at its two Asian plants.

The AGC Group will utilise this EPD to contribute to green purchasing and procurement in the construction industry in Asia. The company will also widen its EPD coverage to high-performance glass products, such as coated glass, double-glazing units and decorative glass manufactured at Asian plants.

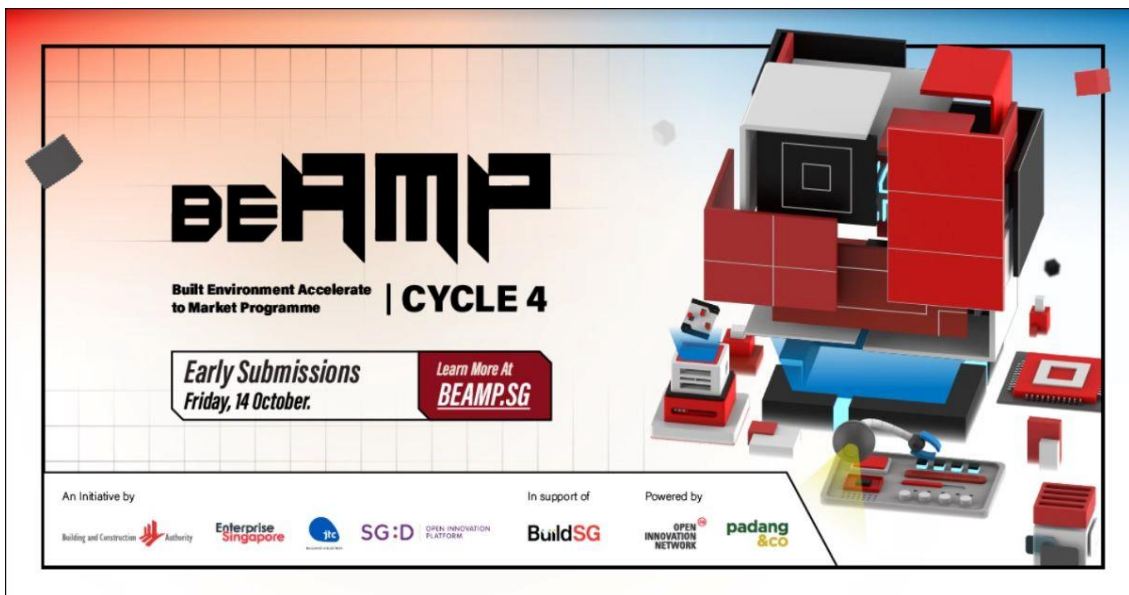
AECOM FastTrack CityHack 2022

Survey: Proposed Industry Guidelines on Formaldehyde Emissions - Adhesives, Composite Wood & Paints

In 2021, the [Singapore Business Federation](#) (SBF), [Singapore Furniture Industries Council](#) (SFIC) and [Singapore Green Building Council](#) (SGBC) formed the [Alliance for Action \(AfA\) on Sustainable Space](#), with the support of the [Building and Construction Authority](#) (BCA) and [National Environment Agency](#) (NEA).

The AfA is recommending a formaldehyde emissions limit of 0.1mg/m³ for all Adhesives and Paints used in interior spaces. This is pegged to the current Singapore Standards 554 (SS 554) and 150 (SS 150) respectively. As for Composite wood, formaldehyde emissions are limited to 0.124mg/m³ in accordance with European Standard (EN 13986).

The AfA is seeking feedback on the proposed formaldehyde emission limit for Adhesives, Composite Wood and Paints, by the end of October 2022.

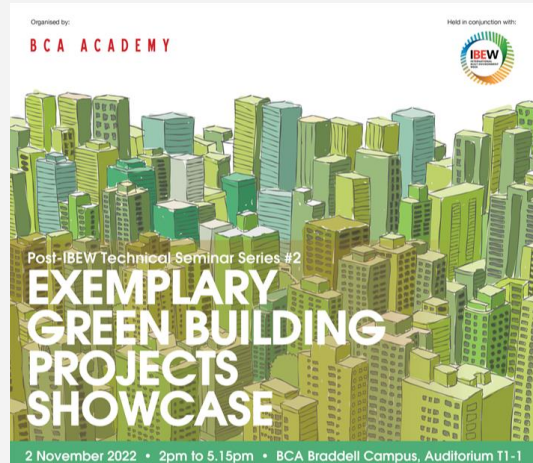

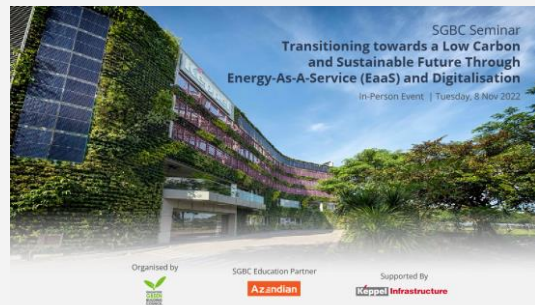
