The building and construction sector is responsible for about 40% of global carbon emissions with the majority coming from energy used to heat, cool and power building operations. A significant amount comes from embodied carbon emission resulting from material manufacturing and construction processes and building maintenance, renovation and demolition. With global building stock expected to double in the next 30 years, action must quickly be taken to reduce upfront carbon.
