



MESSAGE FROM CHAIRMAN

Large construction projects financed by loans from the International Financing Institution (IFI) typically require the use of FIDIC Conditions of Contract, the standard form of contract which is acknowledged as the fair and balance conditions of contract.

Recently most large-scale projects are physically completed successfully, but administrative issues, particularly unresolved construction claims from contractors, remain a persistent challenge. Construction disputes inevitably involve large costs for both the claimant and the defendant, resulting in greater expenses than if the claim could be resolved before escalation to dispute. This shift from Dispute Adjudication Board to Dispute Avoidance and Adjudication Board emphasizes preventative measures.

Given the challenges mentioned above, continuous learning on alternative dispute resolution (ADR) is essential. One key effort involves sharing information from global experiences, international conferences can facilitate this by fostering knowledge exchange. This knowledge can then be used to develop better practices, such as the growing focus on dispute avoidance.

In response to this concern, FIDIC introduced the Dispute Avoidance and Adjudication Board in the FIDIC Conditions of Contract, 2nd Edition 2017 (amended 2022). Additionally, synchronizing the FIDIC Conditions of Contract with national regulations is crucial for preventing disputes altogether. Sharing and discussing these approaches can significantly improve dispute resolution processes.

An International Conference on Dispute Resolution in Asia is crucial for facilitating knowledge sharing among all stakeholders in Asian construction. This includes employers, contractors, consultants, government auditors, and all other relevant parties. By focusing on both the broader Asian region and the specific ASEAN countries, the conference can ensure its impact is comprehensive. The late Gordon L. Jaynes, a world-renowned figure who significantly impacted construction dispute resolution, offered a valuable recommendation before his passing at 93 last year: "Embrace Eastern philosophies that emphasize dispute avoidance."




