Following the successful pilot phase over the past 2 years, the Infrastructure Planning Authority Group (IPAG) of URA will be launching an Industry Guideline on the Major Infrastructure (Network) workflow, as well as the "Infrastructure Network Planning & Alignment Clearance (INPAC)" – a OneStop integrated submission digital platform this year. Building on the positive response and strong support from last year's workshop and URA-IES seminar, URA is excited to organize another workshop come July 2024. This event aims to bring the industry up to speed on the detailed processes, requirements, and deliverables of the workflow, and showcase the features of the newly launched INPAC system. Leveraging on the insights gathered from the industry engagements last year, we also hope to facilitate valuable discussions on these topics.

Introduction to the use of INPAC (IT platform) as a consultation, submission, and approval online platform for alignment clearances for Major Infrastructure (Network) projects undergoing the Major Infrastructure (Network) workflow replacing existing email processes.
