 - i. **Scaling The Hydrogen Economies in Asia** is co-organised by the Energy Market Authority (EMA) and the United States Department of Commerce. The inaugural event will discuss the technical and commercial feasibility of hydrogen, through research and development, as well as financing structures to facilitate hydrogen deployment in Asia.
 - ii. [Asia Carbon Summit](#) will be held as part of the Asia Clean Energy Summit to discuss “Navigating the Complexities of Carbon Markets in Asia”. The Summit will bring together thought leaders for crucial discussions on the rapidly evolving carbon markets and development of tradable carbon reductions, as well as its removal.
