51 experts from across 17 countries participated in the ISO - International Organization for Standardization TC 212 WG 4 meeting, hosted by Singapore Standards Council and CoRE-SDO Team, to discuss the **future of clinical laboratory testing in microbiology and molecular diagnostics**.

Key topics touched upon include AI-driven digital pathology, antibiotic testing, and the **Singapore-led new proposal for a standard on NGS-based assays in key oncology applications** to enhance cancer diagnosis and treatment.

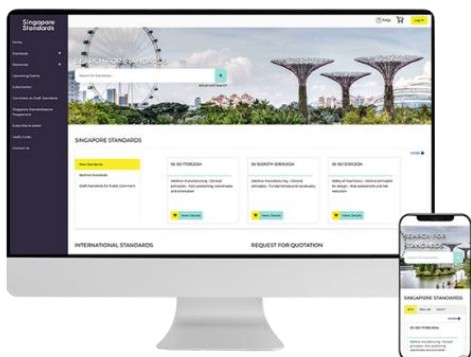
