International Youth Green Innovation Competition 2025

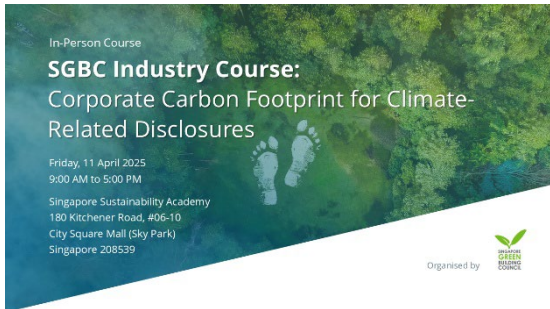

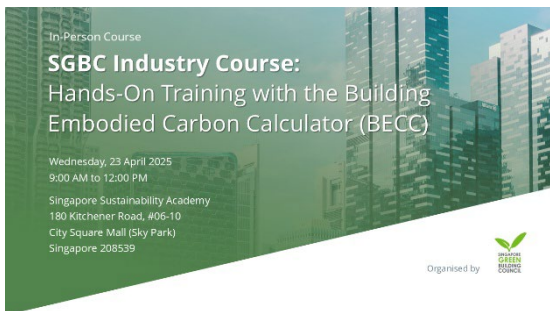
