External Works Submission in **CORENET X**

Under CORENET X, the QP has to submit the proposed external works to the LTA, NParks and PUB for a coordinated regulatory review

Would my project's CG clearance be impacted due to external works?

Development (Internal) & External Works

Under CORENET X, LTA, NParks, and PUB require:

- Proposed works within the development boundary; and
- Proposed external works to be submitted as a single package across the regulatory gateways to ensure that both works are well coordinated.

Clearances and Conditional Approvals

If both external and internal works (with interfacing aspects) are in order:

• Agencies will issue the complete clearances for both internal and external works.

If internal works (with interfacing aspects) are in order but the external works are not resolved yet:

- Agencies will proceed to issue clearance for internal works for the project
- QPs are required to follow up to address the outstanding comments via a joint submission to the agencies overseeing externals works (i.e. LTA, PUB and NParks)

<u>Interfacing aspects that need to be cleared at CG as part of Development (Internal)</u> <u>Works include:</u>

LTA:

- Vehicular & Pedestrian Access Points
- Cyclist Accesses
- Covered Linkways & Walkways
- Pedestrian Overhead Bridges (POBs) & Pedestrian Underpasses (PUPs)
- Bus Stops & Taxi Stands
- Vertical Profile of New Street

PUB:

- Connection of internal drain to road drain/drain outlet
- MPL, adjacent road/ground level, and outlet discharge point levels
- Point of proposed sewer connection

Submission Format & Requirements

For proposed works within the development boundary:

• Submission format shall follow the prevailing BIM submission requirements

For external works details:

 Can be submitted in the 2D CAD format. Agencies are open to reviewing infrastructure models prepared in 3D.

External works submission should comply with LTA, NParks and PUB's external works requirements. More information can be found in the CORENET X Code of Practice (COP) at https://go.gov.sg/cxcop.

Note: External Works requirements are undergoing further refinements. More updates will be released in future COP versions.
