

## SGBC Industry Course: Understanding Life Cycle Assessment for Building Projects

9:00AM to 5:00PM | 22 May 2025 | Instructor-Led In-Person Course



Carbon emissions are a critical metric for understanding and reducing the environmental impact of buildings. Built environment professionals and practitioners are increasingly being required to conduct life cycle assessments (LCA) to quantify the carbon impact building design and retrofit decisions.

As part of the <u>SGBC Carbon Essentials Course Series</u>, the course will provide an overview of embodied carbon emissions and an understanding of a building's LCA through the One Click LCA carbon assessment platform. It will also discuss the role of environmental product declarations (EPD) in material selection and building LCA. Participants will have the opportunity to use the One Click LCA tool with hands-on exercises to conduct LCA of building projects and gain a deeper understanding of potential decarbonisation opportunities.

- Appreciate the role of EPDs and the application of EPD on sustainable buildings
