Setting sail towards a greener maritime future with TRs 129 and 136

Enterprise Singapore and Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore launched two new standards at Singapore Maritime Week 2025 to support maritime sustainability.

[TR 129](#) sets out safety and operational requirements for methanol bunkering, while [TR 136](#) outlines guidelines for safe and interoperable charging of electric harbour crafts. These standards enhance operational safety and build industry confidence in new technologies, ultimately accelerating the transition to cleaner fuels.

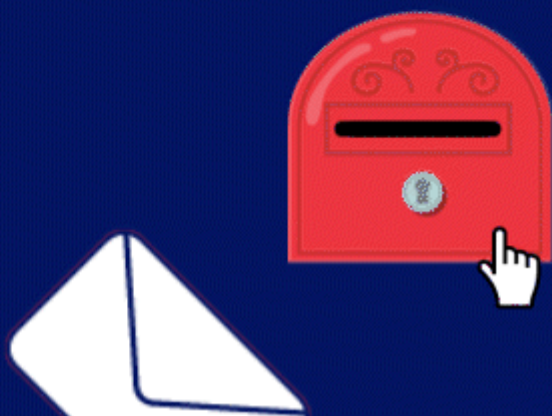

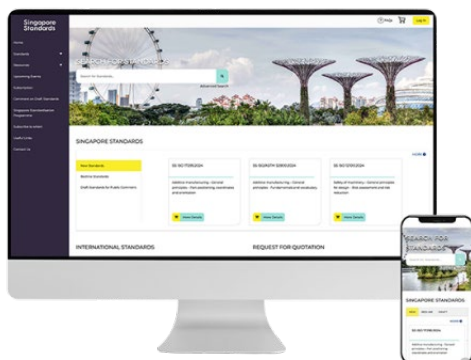
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
