# THE AWARD

**THE ACES YOUNG CONSULTING ENGINEER OF THE YEAR 2025** aims to recognise, celebrate and encourage young consulting engineers working in Singapore. Recipients will be judged to have made a substantial and sustained contribution to their profession and completed excellent work that demonstrates their design and engineering abilities.

**The Award** aim to recognise young engineers who are making an excellent contribution working as a consultant engineer in Singapore. Their attribution may be in one or many of the following areas:

- Passionate at being a consulting engineer
- Substantial technical role in the project team and making a significant impact to the project outcome
- Project or design management

**Award** will be made under three (3) categories\*:-

1. Civil & Structural Engineer
2. Electrical Engineer
3. Mechanical Engineer

\*Young engineers working in associated fields should submit based on their core qualification or the discipline best associated with their practice area.

# THE ELIGIBILITY

- This Award is open to members of the ACES Young Professional Connection.
- Candidates should be based in Singapore working for ACES Corporate member firms.
- The age limit for application is **below 36 years of age** as of time of closing date.
- Candidates should be nominated by Professional Members or Representatives of Corporate Members.
- The Engineer may be leading a single engineering project or be part of a larger project or coordinating a number of projects in or outside of Singapore. These projects may be of any type undertaken by a consulting engineer.
- Applicants should have completed 3 years of full-time employment experience in the construction industry

# THE ASSESSMENT

1	Engineering competency <i>(applicants should focus on technical excellence and demonstrate particular instances where they have tangibly added value or positive impact to the project outcome)</i>	30%
2	Presentation and Communication Skills	20%
3	Creativity / innovation	20%
4	Leadership and Project Management Skills	10%
5	Positive/notable outcomes from their engineering work	10%
6	Contribution to profession and community	10%

# THE JUDGING

## **Submission**

The submission should be done in a formal report format and limited to max. 10 A4 pages excluding cover page.

## **Presentation to Panel of Judges**

The short-listed candidate will be required to put up a presentation on the nominated project at a date to be given by the Panel. The presentation could be in the form of framed slides or PowerPoint slides. This presentation shall not be more than 10 minutes and will be followed by a question and answer session of about 10 minutes.

## **Decision of the Panel**

The decision of the Panel shall be final. The discretion of the Panel to give or withhold an Award is absolute. No form of discussion or correspondence relating to any decisions will be entertained by the Panel.

## **Announcement of Results**

Winners will be informed and the results announced prior to the ACES annual dinner. Awards will be presented during the ACES 54<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Gala Dinner – date to be confirmed.

## **Publication of Materials**

The Association reserves the right, without the payment of fees or royalties, to make whatever use it may consider desirable of all materials submitted in connection with the entries, including the publication of photographs and names, and to select from the entries at its own discretion materials for exhibition or publication, irrespective of the results of the Award.
