Advancing future-ready standards for Singapore's evolving built environment

The Building and Construction Standards Committee Strategic Planning Session, facilitated by IES-Standards Development Organisation (IES-SDO) and Enterprise Singapore, brought together industry and government stakeholders to identify standardisation opportunities addressing evolving needs and technological shifts in the built environment sector.

Discussions highlighted emerging trends, including the need for resilient standards to address ageing infrastructure and climate challenges, the role of green building developments in supporting Singapore's net-zero goals, and the growing use of AI across the construction lifecycle for a future-ready built environment.

Leading the future of manufacturing with Standards and Conformance (S&C)

The Singapore Manufacturing Federation Manufacturing Day Summit 2026 brought together industry leaders to explore how standards and conformance drive innovation in manufacturing. Key discussions focused on safe robotics deployment, AI frameworks that scale value rather than risk, and Digital Product Passports for supply chain transparency. Experts emphasised that standards are strategic investments in customer credibility, not mere compliance exercises, essential for building consumer trust and future-proofing Singapore's manufacturing value chain through robotics, AI, and smart manufacturing technologies.

Cultivating the next generation of food safety professionals

Students from Nanyang Polytechnic's Diploma in Food Science & Nutrition were introduced to food safety standards through a learning session led by NYP-SDO, supported by Enterprise Singapore and Singapore Standards Council to equip the next generation with critical industry knowledge.

The session covered key food safety frameworks, including Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points (HACCP) and Food Safety Management Systems (FSMS), and how standards like [SS 444](#) (HACCP system principles), [SS 630](#) (safe processing of bulk cook chill food), and [SS 668](#) (cold chain logistics) are applied in real-world operations.

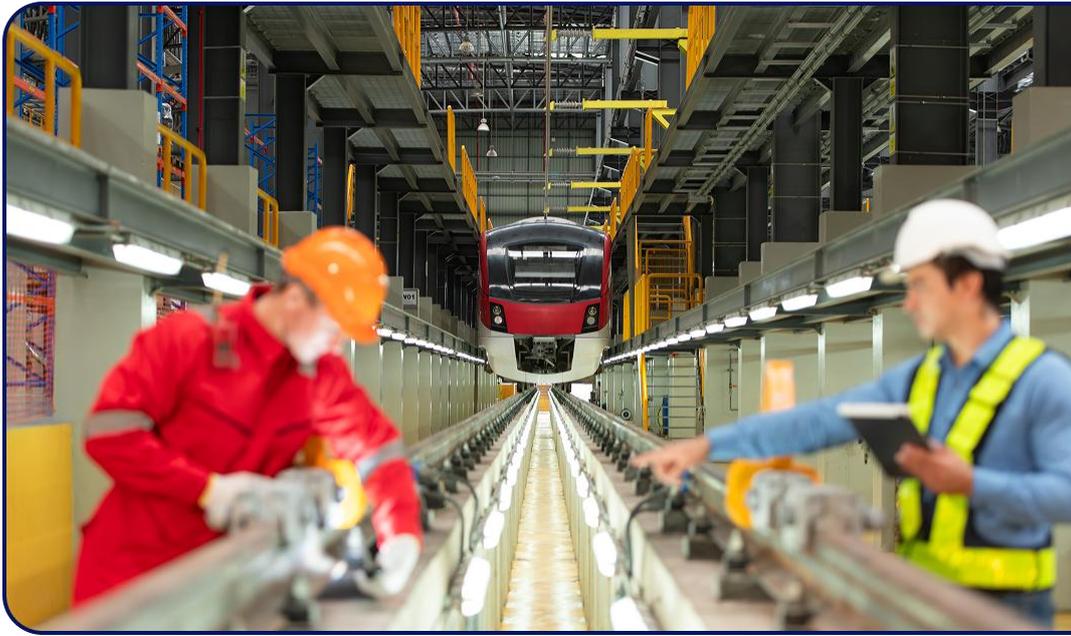

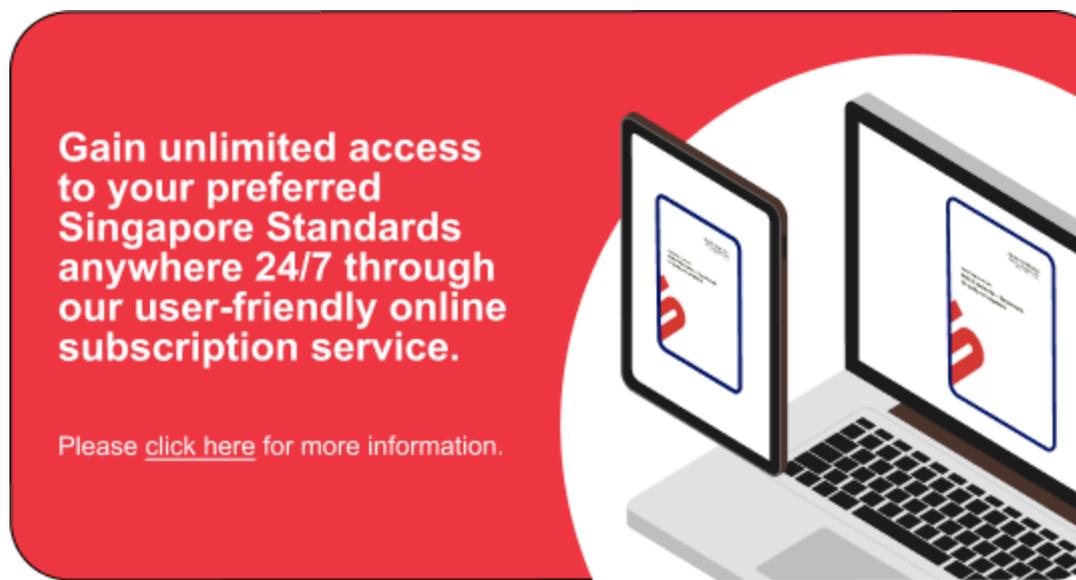

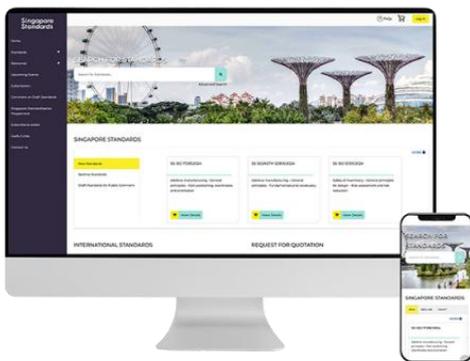
