COMPANION GUIDE TO CODE ON ACCESSIBILITY IN THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT 2025

Objective

This circular announces the launch of the Companion Guide to Code on Accessibility in the Built Environment 2025 (“Companion Guide”).

Background

2 The Code on Accessibility 2025, launched in April 2025, was streamlined to focus on mandatory requirements, enhancing clarity for Qualified Persons.

3 To support Qualified Persons in exceeding these baseline standards, the Companion Guide provides non-mandatory design recommendations and enhanced features that promote user-centric accessibility. It consolidates insights from the Code Review Committee, industry and public feedback, research findings, and current design trends.
