Science-based targets are becoming a baseline expectation as the built environment moves from ambition to action on climate. With Singapore committed to net-zero emissions by 2050, and global capital flows increasingly aligned with credible decarbonisation pathways, the case for understanding frameworks such as the Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTi) is gaining traction. By demystifying what SBTi asks of the buildings sector, the industry can move from uncertainty to informed action.
