## **COORDINATED QUARTERLY RELEASE OF REGULATORY CIRCULARS BY AGENCIES**

Since 5 Jul 2019, the Inter-Agency Coordinating Committee (IACC) has embarked on an initiative to coordinate the release of the respective regulatory agency circulars in batches. This is to address the industry's feedback on the need to keep track of the various agencies' circulars, and suggestion for greater coordination

This initiative covers primarily circulars on regulatory and/or technical requirements. At the same time, whenever possible, the relevant agencies will incorporate a grace period of at least 6 months before the requirements come into effect. Requirements which are time sensitive, such as safety related, or relaxations, may however not be subject to this initiative.

Releases follow a Mar-Jun-Sep-Dec cycle. The current Jun 2026 batch of 4 published circulars are summarized below. You can access the circulars via our new portal at <https://info.corenet.gov.sg/resources/circulars>.
