



SGBC Learning Journey to SolarGy: Reimagining Building Envelopes Through Integrated Solar Façades

Friday, 26 June 2026 | In-Person Event



The transition toward a low-carbon built environment requires the industry to go beyond conventional rooftop solar. Singapore has enhanced its 2030 solar deployment target ahead of schedule, with further plans underway to maximise solar adoption across all viable surfaces. However, with increasing urban density, taller developments, and limited roof space, building façades are emerging as the next frontier of renewable energy generation to meet these progressively ambitious targets.

This SGBC Learning Journey, powered by SGBC Member SolarGy, explores how integrated solar solutions — including building integrated photovoltaics (BIPV), building-attached photovoltaic (BaPV), transparent photovoltaic glazing, and façade-based systems — can transform building envelopes into energy-generating assets while balancing design intent, regulatory compliance, and commercial viability.

Participants will gain practical insights into integrated solar design innovation; Singapore Civil Defence Force (SCDF) and Certificate of Conformity (CoC) approval pathways; fire safety considerations; product applications; and business models that support Green Mark ambitions. Through the technical sharings, product showcases, and real-world case studies, this event aims

to equip industry stakeholders with actionable knowledge to future-proof buildings through integrated solar strategies.
