It reframes the role of the built environment from a resource consumer to a positive contributor, shaping healthy ecosystems and bringing people back in touch with nature, where people and nature co-evolve.

This webinar, supported by SGBC Member AECOM Singapore, draws on insights from Regenerative by Design, authored by David Cheshire, Director at AECOM. The session will explain the mindset shift required to design within planetary boundaries and recognise our dependence on healthy natural systems. Participants can expect to gain an understanding of regenerative design principles and how they can be applied to create resilient, restorative places.

Key principles covered include systems thinking, bio-inspired design, circular economy approaches, and designing within environmental budgets. The session will bring these ideas to life through global case studies, including Google Bay View Campus, Nanjing Eco-Island, Schoonschip, the PAE Living Building, and Green School South Africa. Emerging technologies such as algae façades, microbial fuel cells, and green roofs will also be explored.
