The beta version of the **Safety Advisory and Guidance Engine (SAGE)**, an AI-enabled knowledge and decision-support platform, was announced at the Singapore Workplace Safety and Health (WSH) Conference 2026 on 23 July 2026.

SAGE provides convenient access to trusted, Singapore-specific WSH information. It helps users identify workplace hazards and consider appropriate risk control measures, while supporting, rather than replacing, the professional judgement of WSH practitioners.

To support the refinement of SAGE before its public rollout, we are seeking volunteers to participate in the beta testing exercise. Feedback gathered during this phase will help improve the platform's accuracy, relevance and user experience.
