**PERFORMANCE-BASED FIRE SAFETY PLAN SUBMISSION FOR ADDITION AND ALTERATION (A/A) WORKS**

SCDF issued a circular (Ref: CD/FSSD/12/02/03/010) on 5 June 2012 to inform the building industry that qualified persons (QPs) who carry out any addition and alteration (A/A) works to an existing performance-based (PB) building are required to obtain a Letter of No Objection (LONO) from a fire safety engineer (FSE) if the A/A works do not affect the PB design. If the works affect the PB design, an FSE has to be engaged for the submission of PB plans to SCDF.

2. At the FSE Workshop organised by SCDF on 10 July 2026, SCDF reminded FSEs that LONO can be issued only when the A/A works do not affect the existing performance-based design. If the works affect the PB design, regardless of whether adversely or otherwise, the FSE must submit a PB plan to regularise the changes. FSEs feedback for a review of PB plan submission process for A/A works that do not adversely affect the PB design to minimize project completion delay.

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3. SCDF, together with the SFEG Committee, thus deliberated on a simplified PB plan submission process for A/A works that affect existing PB design of the building. This is premised on the A/A works falling within the scope of the existing Fire Engineering Design Brief (FEDB), accompanied with a declaration from the FSE, instead of preparing another FEDB (see *Annex A* for process).

4. To further shorten the submission process, all required documents including a Fire Engineering Report (FER) to reflect the design changes with an updated simulation study can be submitted by FSE in a single consolidated submission. This is in lieu of the standard 3 separate submissions. The simplified process is expected to shorten the A/A project timeline from 6 months or more to about 2 months.

5. The simplified process will take effect 6 months from date of circular. FSEs who wish to embark on this simplified process during the 6-month grace period can do so.

*Note:* \* An FSE who issues a LONO in place of a PB plan submission where the A&A works affect (regardless whether adversely or non-adversely) the PB design may be subject to:

- (1) Disciplinary action under Section FSA S 43(2) of the FSA, including: cancellation of registration; suspension of registration for up to 12 months; conditions restricting practice for up to 12 months; and/or a penalty not exceeding \$5,000; and
- (2) Criminal liability under Section 41(10) of the FSA: a fine not exceeding \$200,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 2 years, or both.
